

TOEFL® iBT WORLDWIDE INTRODUCTION SCHEDULE

Below is the anticipated schedule for worldwide introduction of the TOEFL® Internet-based test—the TOEFL iBT. The information below indicates the earliest possible administration date for each country or region, and is subject to change. The introduction dates for some countries have not yet been determined and this list will be updated on a regular basis as dates are finalized. Registration opens two months in advance of the first administration in each country.

The Test of Spoken English™ (TSE®) will no longer be offered as a stand-alone test after June 2006 except in countries where TOEFL iBT has not yet been introduced.
